Submission

Please ensure the following during submission:

- Article must be in Word document.
- The author (or main author, if more than one) of the article is required to provide his/her signature in the [Assignment of Copyright Form](#) prior to publication.
- Any images included should be high-resolution (min. 300 dpi).

The publication of all contribution articles is subjected to the *SingTeach* editorial team's decision. If deemed suitable for readers, the article will also be edited for clarity and house style.
