- The author (or main author, if more than one) of the article is required to provide his/her signature in the Assignment of Copyright Form prior to publication.
- Images (if any) should be high-resolution (min. 300 dpi).

The publication of articles is subjected to the *SingTeach* editorial team's decision. If deemed suitable for readers, the article will also be edited for clarity and house style.
